This course is offered to *occupational therapists, physiotherapists, speech-language pathologists and PTA/OTAs* who work with children. Applicants must be familiar with typical motor development. Casual, comfortable clothing is recommended for mat work.

Intro NDT Course Objectives:

1. To develop a greater understanding of the required prerequisite sensory motor components and patterns of development in the first 12 months.
2. To understand the typical postures and movement patterns demonstrated by children with abnormal tone.
3. To increase awareness of selected functional consequences of abnormal tone, as related to typical motor development.
4. To understand the basic principles of Neurodevelopmental Theory.
5. To develop a basic understanding of the facilitation of movement and acquire a basic level of competence in facilitating movement.
6. To demonstrate a basic understanding of postural reflex mechanism
